[d] Board fee covers the cost of 16 meal cards; extra cards can be purchased at cost.

[e] Charged to all resident students. Refundable at end of school year, less any charges for loss or damage to facilities.

[f] Charged for each transcript. Transcripts issued only when student's account is in satisfactory condition.

[g] Charged to all students bringing vehicles to campus. Heater service available at designated lots only.

[h] Cost subject to change. May be waived with proof of health insurance.

## PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Full semester expenses are payable at time of registration or in two equal installments as follows:

**Fall Semester:** 1/2 at Registration and 1/2 by October 7, 2009

**Spring Semester:** 1/2 on January 11, 2010 and 1/2 by February 19, 2010

Accounts not paid in full by the end of the 6th week of each semester will be subject to late charges

## OUTSTANDING BALANCES

Students with outstanding account balances will not be allowed to re-enroll.

Grades, transcripts, and diplomas will not be released until the student's account is paid in full.
