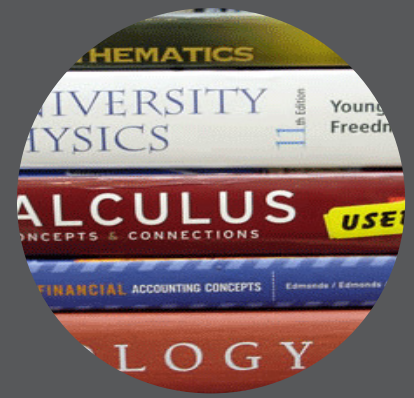


# Finish High While Starting College



## Earn FREE college credit at Oak Hills Christian College with Post Secondary Enrollment Options (PSEO)

The Post-Secondary Enrollment Options Act allows high school juniors and seniors to take college-level, nonsectarian courses with Oak Hills Christian College and earn both high school and college credit.

The PSEO program, funded through the Minnesota Department of Education, covers the high school student's tuition and cost of textbooks for college-level courses (numbered 1000 level or higher).

## COST-SAVING EXAMPLES

If you were to attend OHCC for four years without PSEO, tuition could cost as much as \$60,000. If you take PSEO courses at OHCC, those courses transfer in and reduce your total 4-year cost of attendance.

If you transfer in a semesters worth of PSEO courses, your potential tuition of \$60,000 would be reduced to \$52,250. A 4-year savings of \$7,750.

If you transfer in two semesters worth of PSEO courses, your potential tuition of \$60,000 would be reduced to \$44,500.

A 4-year savings of \$15,500.
